



## **Recovery Coach Internship Opportunity**

**Description:** Eskenazi Health Midtown Community Mental Health is seeking a trained recovery coach through the Project PEERS grant to assist in a variety of recovery based activities at Eskenazi Health Center Grassy Creek, a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) with the possibility of working at other locations. This would be a full time position with Eskenazi Health as part of the Opioid Learning Collaborative.

### **Responsibilities:**

- Peer recovery coach will support Eskenazi Health's mission by providing mentoring, peer support, and operational support for peer led recovery groups and pro-social activities across the agency, including supporting the volunteer fellowship of men and women looking to attain and maintain their sobriety.
- Assist other addiction staff with facilitating recovery groups and pro-social activities.
- Assist in helping clients meet their treatment/ services plans to promote successful recovery.
- Assist full time staff with one-on-one coaching of client's in early recovery.
- Maintain accurate documentation and record keeping of client's activities and progress.
- Ensure all agency rules are followed during peer led recovery groups and pro-social activities both on campus and off.
- Report all safety concerns to the appropriate staff or immediate supervisor.
- Work environment would be in a busy medical clinic with interactions with medical personnel.

### **Qualifications:**

- Minimum of 1 year continuous recovery.
- Successful completion of the PEERS Grant CCAR Recovery Coach Training.
- Knowledge of the recovery process and willingness to follow Midtown's recovery procedures.
- Can-do attitude, hardworking and reliable.
- Ability to work independently or part of a team.
- Must complete a background check.
- Must have a TB test and provide results to supervisor.
- Must agree to meet weekly for supervision with assigned Peer Coach/ staff.
